The Council has extended its service provision with the introduction of new mausoleum and burial chamber interment facilities at the Cemetery.


The mausoleum offers two options for interment: front interment and side interment.


There are 12 front interment positions and 6 side interment positions.

Burial chambers are set below ground and each chamber can accept up to two interments.
Once an interment has taken place, the compartment is sealed with slabs.

There are 24 burial chambers available and each chamber has a provision for floral tributes and a decorative stone memorial housing for an inscribed plaque.








The mausoleum also contains Keepsake Niches which can be used for the safe keeping of memorial tributes and personal mementoes.

Each door is furnished with toughened glass and secured with tamper-proof fixings and locks.





Keepsake niches

An express inscription and memorialisation service is available on request at the Cemetery Office.

Mausoleum tablets and burial chamber memorial tablets can be inscribed in memory of the deceased. Ornaments and photoplaques can be purchased and fixed to the tablets.

Mausoleum side interment inscription


